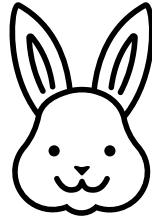

Welcome from your Head...

Dear Parents, Carers, and Members of our School Community,

Welcome to our end of Term 4 Newsletter.

Firstly, I would like to extend a huge thank you to you all for your support with raising attendance at school. We have a school target for the end of the year to reach 96% and we are currently close to achieving this with a current attendance figure of 95.4%. If you do have any concerns regarding your child's attendance, please do make an appointment to see your class teacher to discuss ways in which we can support you and your child.

Secondly, thank you for all of your support and commitment to your children's education. Year 6 have begun their preparations for SATs, and as a result will be bringing home CGP revision books so please do continue to support your children with completing these. Times Table Rockstars participation has dramatically increased which will be a great support for Year 4 who will complete their Multiplication Times Table Check. As well as this, our Year 1 children will soon be completing their Phonics Screening Check, which again has seen huge benefits from the commitment at home to read regularly.

This term has been small but full of big opportunities for the children. The start of the term started with an incredible Young Voices performance, which will be long remembered by staff, pupils and parents. It was fantastic to be in the audience during the recent Performance Arts Festival at FCC, in which a group of Key Stage 2 children performed the violin to a large audience. We've also had Bikeability for our eldest children and a fabulous iRock concert, as well an exciting and vibrant Easter Bonnet Parade which really goes to show big things happen in our small school.

On Thursday, during our Easter Service, we announced that Lizzie and Isabel had been awarded the Child of the Term awards. Both girls were mentioned for their maturity, kindness and showing their happiness around school – they both fully demonstrate all of our school vision and values!

Finally, as you will be aware, our year groups continue to remain low and we have spaces across the school. We have a range of marketing materials such as flyers and social media posts. Please can you consider if you are able to share flyers in the local area or continue to share social media posts. On recent tours, it has been commented that Ashbury is often recommended on social media which has been very pleasing to hear. We also hope to be able to share our recent Ofsted inspection report shortly, which we hope will also bring more children to our school.

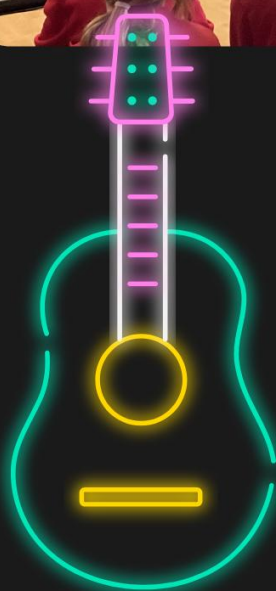
